From Ashes to Beauty

*To console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified. **Isaiah 61:3 (NKJV)***

*After Job had prayed for his friends, the Lord restored his fortunes and gave him twice as much as he had before. **Job 42:10 (NIV)***
