Grace for the Final Stretch

*Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain! **Zechariah 4:7***

*Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. **Hebrews 4:16***

The final stretch of any race is often the most challenging. Fatigue sets in, distractions increase, and the temptation to slow down or give up becomes real. Yet it is also the stretch that matters most—the moment that defines whether you will simply be a starter or a finisher. God has not brought you this far to leave you stranded.
